Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **JAMEX, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A in the Bull Creek Field, Union Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate in the Bull Creek Field, Union Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated CV RA SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To designate JAMEX, INC., as the operator of the unit.
4. To designate the JAMEX, INC.-Adkins 20 No. 1 well as the unit well for the proposed unit.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled in the CV RA SUA should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of the Office of Conservation Orders relating to the Bull Creek Field, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
7. To authorize the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Zone, in Bull Creek Field, Union Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 7,885 feet and 9,310 feet, electrical log depths, in the JAMEX, Inc. -Adkins 20 No. 1 well (SN 234613), located in Section 20, Township 21 North, Range 3 West, Union Parish, Louisiana.



This conference was not held since a specific request to confer was not made to the writer, either by telephone or in writing, by an Interested Owner or Represented Party receiving a copy of this notice. No opposition to this application, therefore, is anticipated.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties, and Represented Parties to whom a copy of this notice is being furnished. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties, and Represented Parties.

Finally, enclosed is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation submitted on behalf of the applicant representing the hearing application fee.



