Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **JAMES A. WHITSON, JR.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Robulus 43-3 Sand, Reservoir B, in Southwest Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Robulus 43-3 Sand, Reservoir B, in Southwest Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated ROB 43-3 RB SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Robulus 43-3 Sand, Reservoir B, in the Southwest Lake Boeuf Field, within or outside the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the aforementioned zone and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Robulus 43-3 Sand, in the Southwest Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 473-C, effective February 1, 1973.



The conference was opened by representatives of the applicant who explained the bases for the unit being requested. Several questions were asked and answered. The conference was then adjourned. We do not anticipate any opposition at the hearing to be scheduled for this matter.


