Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Bethany-Longstreet Field**, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R, effective April 1, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 289-R Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create three (3) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units to be designated HA RA SU II, HA RA SU JJ, and HA RA SU KK;

2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate a unit well for the proposed units, if appropriate;
4. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of the proposed units, if appropriate;
5. To provide that with respect to any future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the proposed units, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary or other well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has granted to drill, to said reservoir, will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforations in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
6. To extend to the proposed units, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 298-R, effective April 1, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 289-R Series of Orders; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R, effective April 1, 2008, and was redefined by Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R-3, effective June 25, 2008.

The pre-application conference tentatively scheduled for October 8th, 2008, **WILL NOT BE HELD**, as it was not requested within the delays provided for by the Rules of Procedure; therefore, no opposition to this Application at the hearing is anticipated.

However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort




