APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Justiss Oil Company, Inc/Munoco Company, P.O. Box 2990, Jena, LA 71342, for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1) To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Order 1106-A in order to permit the utilization of the Justiss Oil Company Inc/Munoco Company Placid Fee NS No. 6 well at a location 139 feet from the South line and 589 feet from the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, Louisiana Principal Meridian, North of Red River Land District, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

2) To designate the Justiss Oil Company Inc/Munoco Company Placid Fee NS No. 6 well as a substitute unit well for the Wilcox A, Reservoir A, Sand Unit L as defined and described by Order No. 1106-A at an exceptional location.

3) To determine that the proposed location will effectively and efficiently drain portions of the reservoir which would not otherwise be drained by the existing wellbore in WX A RA SUL absent the approval of the exceptional location.

4) To designate Justiss Oil Company, Inc/Munoco Company as the operator of the unit.

5) To consider any and all other matters which the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

Order 1106-A was promulgated by the Office of Conservation on July 11, 1989 establishing rules and regulations and creating drilling and producing units for the North Searcy Field of LaSalle Parish, Louisiana for the Wilcox A through C Zones, Reservoir A. The order provides that additional wells located in the North Searcy Field, within or outside any of the units created thereby, should not be drilled within 330 feet of any unit boundary or within 660 feet of any other well which has been permitted for, drilled to or completed in the same zone.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Order 1106-A as that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 1893 feet and 2690 feet (electric log measurements) in the Hunt Petroleum Corporation - IPB LLS No. 69 Well, located in the NE/4 of SE/4 of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

The original unit well for WX A RA SUL, the Placid Fee NS No. 3 was plugged and abandoned on September 15, 2008.

The applicant attaches hereto a plat showing the proposed location for which this special permit is sought.

Inasmuch as the matters covered by this application do not require a pre-application notice, no such notice has been given and it is requested that the hearing be held after the necessary ten day delay following legal advertisement.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the applicant has made a diligent effort to obtain the names and addresses of all interested owners and represented parties to whom notice of this application should be sent and a list of such names is attached hereto.

The applicant will also cause a copy of the legal notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in LaSalle Parish, Louisiana and shall post a copy of the notice in a prominent place in the LaSalle Parish Courthouse.

A copy of this letter, the attached plat and list of interested owners and represented parties is being sent to the District Manager of the Monroe District Office.

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$755.00 in payment of the required filing fees.


