Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **LIBERTY RESOURCES, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the **Sparta Sand, Reservoir B**, in the **Livonia Field**, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, such unit to be designated SP RB SUA;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate the Liberty Resources, Inc. – Beauvias No. 1 Well as the unit well for the proposed unit;

4. To designate Liberty Resources, Inc. as the unit operator for the proposed unit;
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, within the proposed unit, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
6. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, outside of the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
8. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, in Livonia Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,716 feet and 10,741 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Liberty Resources, Inc. – Beauvais No. 1 Well, located in Section 119, Township 6 South, Range 9 East, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held at 2:00 p.m. on the 19th day of December 2007, at The Onebane Law Firm, 1200 Camellia Blvd, Suite 300, Lafayette, Louisiana 70502, (337) 237-2660. A list of the parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. Randall C. Songy, attorney for the applicant, opened the conference with a brief discussion of the Rules of Procedure. Louis Gilbert, geological consultant for the applicant, explained the applicant's proposal and the geological, engineering and other bases therefore, and answered questions. No counterplan was presented and the conference was then adjourned.




