Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Hilcorp Energy Company for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 10400' RAB-1 SUA, located in the Paradis Field, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, created by Office of Conservation Order No. 37-HH, effective June 19, 1984.

1. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company - LL & E No. 94 Well, located in Section 39, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, in the Paradis Field, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, as a substitute unit well.
2. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to this application.

The designation of the well as a substitute unit well is necessary and in the interest of conservation to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the 10400' RAB-1 SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within such unit. The present unit well, the LL & E No. 92 Well, ceased to produce from the 10400' RAB-1 SUA in May, 1989.

The 10400' Sand, Reservoir AB-1, in the Paradis Field, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 37-HH, effective June 19, 1984.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof a plat identifying the subject unit created by Conservation Order No. 37-HH, along with the location of the proposed substitute unit well. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, a list of names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties to whom this application is being sent is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list will be provided to any party requesting a copy. A diligent effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

Finally there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Hilcorp Energy Company, in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.




