APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

WSF, Inc. hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo and Bossier Parishes, Louisiana:

1. To authorize WSF, Inc. to drill, complete and utilize an additional alternate unit well on HOSS RA SU29, CV RA SU29 and LCV RA SU71 in Section 15-T16N-R12W, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, at the location shown on the attached plats;
2. To authorize WSF, Inc. to drill, complete and utilize an additional alternate unit well on HOSS RA SU30, CV RA SU30 and LCV RA SU82 in Section 14-T16N-R12W, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, at the exceptional location shown on the attached plats;
3. To authorize WSF, Inc. to drill, complete and utilize an additional alternate unit well on HOSS RA SU41, CV RA SU41 and LCV RA SU72 in Section 22-T16N-R12W, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, at the exceptional location shown on the attached plats;
4. To authorize WSF, Inc. to drill, complete and utilize two additional alternate unit wells on HOSS RA SU40, CV RA SU40 and LCV RA SU83 in Section 23-T16N-R12W, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, at the exceptional locations shown on the attached plats;

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5. To find that each of the proposed alternate unit wells is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the respective units which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well;
6. To authorize the unit allowable for these Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, units to be recovered from the any of the wells located on the units, at the discretion of the operator; and
7. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-A-1, effective October 1, 1972, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-A-5, effective May 25, 1977, and subsequent orders of the 361-A Series of Orders.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-B, effective October 1, 1973, and was further defined by subsequent orders of the 361-B Series.

The Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-E, effective July 16, 1996, and was redefined insofar as certain units are concerned by Office of Conservation Order No. 361-E-265, effective June 7, 2005.

The subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a Pre-Application Notice.


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requesting a copy of it. Enclosed with the copy of this letter being sent to the Office of Conservation is a check for the application fee.
