Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **LEGGETT PETROLEUM LLC**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 4850' Sand, Reservoir C in the North Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and recreate a drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate in the North Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated 4850'00 RC SUA
2. To permit the applicant, **LEGGETT PETROLEUM LLC**, to designate and utilize the Leggett Petroleum LLC.-Harmon No.5 well as the unit well for the 4850' RC SUA, shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof, at an exceptional location to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 423-MM.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
4. To designate **LEGGETT PETROLEUM LLC** as the operator of the unit.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled in the 4850' RC SUA should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of the Office of Conservation Order No. 423-MM relating to the 4851' Sand, Reservoir C, in North Crowley Field, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
7. To authorize the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoirs by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoirs change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 4850' Sand, in North Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined by Order No. 423-MM, effective October 1, 1972.



A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was tentatively scheduled for 10:30 A.M. on Thursday, January 31, 2008, at the Petroleum Club of Lafayette, 111 Heymann Blvd., Lafayette, Louisiana. This conference was not held since a specific request to confer was not made to the writer by an Interested Owner or Represented Party receiving a copy of this notice. No opposition to this application is anticipated. It should be noted that the plat sent out with the Notice of Application was incorrect as to the distance of the proposed unit well from adjoining leases because of a drafting error. The correct distance is shown on the attached proposed unit plat. If any interested party has any questions or desires to confer, please contact the undersigned.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties, and Represented Parties to whom a copy of this notice is being furnished. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties, and Represented Parties.

Finally, enclosed is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation submitted on behalf of the applicant representing the hearing application fee.
