

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 1, 2008**, upon the application of **FRANKS EXPLORATION COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Zone and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston Zone.
2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interest located within the proposed unit for the Hosston Zone in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To authorize the down hole or well bore combination of hydrocarbons produced from the Hosston Zone and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, insofar as proposed HOSS SU57 and existing CV RA SUI are concerned provided the ownership within said units and zones are the same.
4. To designate a unit well for HOSS SU57 at the exceptional location shown on the plat submitted with the application and to designate an operator for said unit well.
5. To extend the field rules for the Hosston Zone to the proposed unit, except to the extent inconsistent herewith.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Zone was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 28-S, effective April 21, 1970.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was defined in Order No. 28-W-1, effective October 15, 1982.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
