EL PASO E&P COMPANY, L.P. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, and to the Hosston C Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bear Creek Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit Applicant to drill, designate and utilize its J. L. Jordan et al. No. 6 Well as an additional alternate unit well for HOSS B RA SUP, and as an alternate unit well for HOSS C RA SUQ, at the location shown on the attached plats.
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, underlying HOSS B RA SUP, and a portion of the Hosston C Zone, Reservoir A, underlying HOSS C RA SUQ, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within these units.
3. To approve the downhole combination of production from the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, and the Hosston C Zone, Reservoir A, in the wellbore of the proposed well and in the wellbore of any other wells located on these units in which the ownership interests in the Hosston B Zone unit are identical to the ownership interests in the Hosston C Zone unit.
4. To permit the operator of HOSS C RA SUQ to produce the allowable assigned to this unit from either the unit well, from the alternate unit well, or from a combination of such wells, at the option of the operator.
5. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bear Creek Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 78-Q, effective February 18, 1971, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 78-Q-8, effective July 6, 1982.

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The Hosston C Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bear Creek Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 78-Y, effective September 11, 1980.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Boulevard, Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person desiring to inspect any such data should call Mr. Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the application fee is enclosed.
