

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 1, 2008**, upon the application of **WSF, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo and Bossier Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To authorize WSF, Inc. to complete and utilize an additional alternate unit well on HOSS RA SU42, at the exceptional location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of HOSS RA SU42 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well located on the unit.
3. To authorize the unit allowable for HOSS RA SU42 to be recovered from any of the wells located on the unit, at the discretion of the operator.
- 4 . To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-A-1, effective October 1, 1972, and was further defined in Order No. 361-A-5, effective May 25, 1977, and subsequent orders of the 361-A Series.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
