

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 1, 2008**, upon the application of **EOG RESOURCES, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Sligo Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize EOG Resources, Inc. to drill, designate and utilize a horizontal lateral as an additional alternate unit well for LCV RA SUN at the location and in the manner generally shown on the plat submitted with the application, provided that said well may be drilled along a path and to a bottom hole location within a fifty foot (50') radius of the path and bottom hole location shown on the plat submitted with the application, provided further that in no event is said well closer than 330 feet to any unit boundary.
2. To approve an exception to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 8-K, effective October 16, 1990, as necessary, for the proposed alternate unit well as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To establish that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to recover hydrocarbons from LCV RA SUN that cannot be produced from any other well located on this unit.
4. To authorize the unit allowable for LCV RA SUN to be recovered from the existing wells located on the unit, the proposed alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was fully defined in Order No. 8-K, effective on and after October 16, 1990.
