Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **SWEPI LP** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters:

## **Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A – Trenton Field**

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create eight (8) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Trenton Field, Desoto Parish, Louisiana, said units to be designated JUR RA SUA through JUR RA SUH, all as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in Trenton Field, within or outside the units created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Trenton Field, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

**Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A – Oxford Field**

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create six (6) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Oxford Field, Desoto Parish, Louisiana, said units to be designated JUR RA SUA through JUR RA SUF, all as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in Oxford Field, within or outside the units created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Oxford Field, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

**Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A – Brushy Bayou Field**

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create two (2) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Brushy Bayou Field, Desoto Parish, Louisiana, said units to be designated JUR RA SUA and JUR RA SUB, all as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in Brushy Bayou Field, within or outside the units created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in the Brushy Bayou Field, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Jurassic Zone, Reservoir A, in Trenton, Oxford and Brushy Bayou Fields, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 9,870 feet and 13,385 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Phillips Petroleum Company – Martin “B” No. 1 Well, located in Section 32, Township 11 North, Range 10 West, Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana.

Any pertinent data, including well logs, not available from the Office of Conservation, may be obtained **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY** from W. H. Robbins & Associates, L.L.C., 302 La Rue France, Lafayette, Louisiana 70508, Telephone Number (337) 232-5004.

Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, pre-application notice was given; however, no request for the conference was received. Therefore, the conference tentatively scheduled for March 19, 2008, **WILL NOT BE HELD**.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are plats outlining the applicant’s proposals along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such plats (being the same plats attached to the pre-application notice dated February 25, 2008) and list of parties are being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation; however, the plats and/or list of parties will be furnished to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

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



