Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Robulus 1 Sand, Reservoir C, in the East Lake Palourde Field, Assumption Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the applicant, **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**, to designate and utilize the Hilcorp Energy Company (formerly Union Oil Co. of California)-P. R. Norman No. C-2 well (SN 74116) as an alternate unit well for the **ROB 1 RC SUB** unit, shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof, said well being at an exceptional location to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 357-D-2.
2. To designate Hilcorp Energy Company as the operator of the unit.
3. To permit the Operator of **ROBU 1 RC SUB** to produce the unit allowable for the aforesaid unit from either the unit well or the alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, at the discretion of the Operator of said unit.
4. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of the 357-D Series of Office of Conservation Orders relating to the Robulus 1 Sand, Reservoir C, in East Lake Palourde Field, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Robulus 1 Sand, Reservoir C, in East Lake Palourde Field, Assumption Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined by Order No. 357-D, effective March 1, 1959, and further defined by Order No. 357-D-2, effective February 6, 1974.




