Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B**, and the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Bethany-Longstreet Field**, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B, such unit to be designated CV RB SUA;
2. To create two (2) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units to be designated HA RA SUB and HA RA SUC;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with

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- each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. – Sellers et al 22 No. 1 Well as the unit well for CV RB SUA;
 5. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of CV RB SUA;
 6. To designate the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. – Sustainable Forests et al 23 H No. 1 Well as the unit well for HA RA SUB;
 7. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of HA RA SUB;
 8. To provide that any future well drilled to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B, within or outside of the proposed unit, should be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit boundary and no closer than 660 feet to any other well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to said reservoir;
 9. To extend to HA RA SUB and HA RA SUC, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all field rules adopted by the Office of Conservation for this reservoir; and
 10. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,910 feet and 11,487 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. – SRLT 29 No. 1 Well, located in Section 29, Township 16 North, Range 15 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana and is hereby further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 11,008 feet and 11,585 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. – Bray 27 No. 1 Well located in Section 27, Township 15 North, Range 16 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

The Cotton Valley Formation, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974 and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J-1, effective April 14, 1977.

A unitization proposal for the establishment of rules and regulations and the creation of a single drilling and production unit for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, is currently pending. An Application, dated February 12, 2008, for the creation of HA RA SUA has already been filed with the Office of Conservation and mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties. The hearing is scheduled for April 1, 2008.






