RE: Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A  
Mermentau River Field  
Acadia Parish, Louisiana

Application is hereby made on behalf of **PetroQuest Energy, L.L.C.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A**, in the **Mermentau River Field**, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

- A. To determine that unitization of the Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A, is unnecessary because the entirety of the reservoir lies beneath a single tract;
- B. In the alternative, and only in the event the Commissioner determines that the reservoir lies beneath more than one tract, then:
  1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A, such unit to be designated CAM 1 RA SUA;

2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate the PetroQuest Energy, L.L.C. – Cary Estate No. 1 Well as the unit well for the proposed unit;
4. To designate PetroQuest Energy, L.L.C. as the operator of the proposed unit;
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A, within or outside of the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Mermentau River Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,314 feet and 12,367 feet (electrical log measurements) in the PetroQuest Energy, L.L.C. – Cary Estate No. 1 Well, located in Section 64, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.


A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held at 2:00 p.m. on the 26th day of March, 2008, at The City Club at River Ranch, 1100 Camellia Blvd., Lafayette, Louisiana, (337) 406-2582. A list of the parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. Randall C. Songy, attorney for the applicant, opened the conference with a brief discussion of the Rules of Procedures. Bill McAllister, geological consultant for the applicant, explained the applicant's proposal and the geological, engineering and other bases therefor, and answered questions. Counterplans were submitted by David Sturlese, on behalf of Thibodeaux, et al, and by Travis Helms, on behalf of H. Smith, et al. The parties were unable to resolve their differences at the conference but agreed to continue discussing a resolution after the conference. The conference was then adjourned.

A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, enclosed herein is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation in payment of the required hearing application fee.




**PRODUCTIVE AREA**
