Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made under the Revised Rules of procedure, on behalf of **TOLAR ENERGY, LLC** ("Applicant") for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Miogypsinoides Zone, Reservoir E & F in the West Gueydan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana:

MIOGYPSINOIDES ZONE, RESERVOIR E, SU A

1. To dissolve the unit designated MIOGYP RE SU A created by Office of Conservation Order No. 52-DD-7, effective February 1, 2005 and to simultaneously therewith create a revised MIOGYP RE SU A of approximately 495 acres.
2. Except as they may be in conflict herewith, to continue in force and effect the provisions of Order No. 52-DD-7.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

MIOGYPSINOIDES ZONE, RESERVOIR F, SU A

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 420 acres for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Miogypsinoides Zone, Reservoir F in West Gueydan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana; and

2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Miogypsinoides Zone, Reservoir F shall comply with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
4. Except as they may be in conflict herewith, to extend the provisions of Order No. 52-DD-7, effective February 1, 2005 to the MIOGYF RF SU A.
5. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Miogypsinoides Zone in the West Gueydan Field was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 52-DD, effective March 9, 1999 and was further defined in Office of Conservation order No. 52-DD-7 and is hereby defined for MIOGYF RF as that stratigraphic interval encountered between the depths of 17,160 feet and 18,000 feet (16,999 feet and 17,750 feet TVD) (electrical log measurements) in the Sandefer Petroleum Company - Vincent Reese No. 1 well located in section 31, Township 11 South, Range 2 West, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application was offered; however since no request was received the conference was not held.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is the applicant's proposed unit, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, interested parties and represented parties to whom this application is being sent. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties. A copy of the Interested Parties List is being mailed to the Commissioner of Conservation and the District manager of the Lafayette District only. Should any party desire a copy of this list, we will be glad to provide one upon request.

Applicant will provide for POSTING of a copy of the legal notice of the hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause the LEGAL NOTICE to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of the West Gueydan Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice



to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice.


Also enclosed is a check, in the amount of \$ 1,510.00, payable to the Louisiana Office of Conservation, which represents the required hearing fee.

± 495 ACRES**


