Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **CENCO, Inc.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Marg Tex-Marg Howei Zone, Reservoir A, Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 519 acres for the Marg Tex-Marg Howei Zone, Reservoir A, designated as the MT-MH RA SUA, Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the unit created herein;
5. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Marg Vag - Marg Howei Zone, Reservoir A in the Kaplan Field, is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 14,330 feet and 16,100 feet (electrical log measurements) in the CENCO, Inc. (formerly Petrus Operating Co.)-Broussard No. 1 Well (SN 203077) located in Section 9, Township 12 South, Range 2 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana on March 26, 2008. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of the names and addresses of the parties who were in attendance at that conference.

The conference was opened by Mr. William F. Bailey. Mr. Remy Williams of W. H. Robbins & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. Mr. David Sturlese on behalf of the Vermilion Parish School Board presented a plan of a 519 acre geographic unit being the unit previously adopted for the CAM 1 RI SUA. Mr. Tim Broussard on behalf of himself, Jim Broussard and Esther Dean Wood proposed a plan to extend the south line of the original proposed unit to add 50 acres to the unit. The unit has been revised to add approximately 49 acres to the south of the originally proposed unit. It is anticipated that there may be opposition at the public hearing on this matter.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a revised plat outlining the MT-MH RA SUA, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom this notice is being sent. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.

Upon receipt of the legal notice in the captioned matter, the notice will be posted, published and mailed in accordance with Rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure.
