Application is hereby made on behalf of **CAMTERRA RESOURCES, INC.**, (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a public hearing to considered evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, Elm Grove Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilized a horizontal lateral as an additional alternate unit well for the production of gas and condensate for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, Elm Grove Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, in the unit designated CV RA SU101, such well and unit shown on the attached plat and being made a part hereof, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order 361-B effective October 1, 1973.
2. To find that an alternate unit well on the CV RA SU101 is necessary to assist in draining a portion of the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, that cannot be drained by any other well located therein.
3. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable form the unit well, the alternate unit wells or form a combination of all wells at its discretion
4. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may may deem pertinent and appropriate.
