

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 13, 2008**, upon the application of **JUSTISS OIL COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, SUI**, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1106-A so as to permit the drilling and production of the Justiss Oil Company, Inc.-Placid Fee MA No. 6 Well at a location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To designate the Justiss Oil Company-Placid Fee MA No. 6 Well as an alternate unit well for the WX A RA SUI as defined and described by Order No. 1106-A referenced herein below at said exceptional location and to permit the operator to produce the unit allowable from the existing well(s) on the unit, the proposed alternate unit well, or from any combination thereof, at is discretion, and to designate Justiss Oil Company, Inc. as the unit operator.
3. To determine that the proposed location will effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir which would not otherwise be drained, absent the approval of the exceptional location.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, was defined in Order No. 1106-A as that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 1,893' and 2,690' (electric log measurements) in the Hunt Petroleum Corporation-IPB LLS No. 69 Well, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East.
