APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Justiss Oil Company, Inc., P.O. Box 2990, Jena, LA 71342, for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1) To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Order 1106-A so as to permit the drilling and production of the "Justiss Oil Company, Inc. Placid Fee MA No. 6" well at a location approximately 440 feet from the South line and also approximately 125 feet from the West line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

2) To designate the "Justiss Oil Company, Inc. Placid Fee MA No. 6" well as an alternate unit well for the WX A RA SUI as defined and described by Order No. 1106-A referenced hereinbelow at said exceptional location, and to permit the operator to produce the unit allowable from the existing well(s) on the unit, the proposed alternate unit well, or from any combination thereof, at its discretion, and to designate Justiss Oil Co., Inc. as the unit operator.

3) To determine that the proposed location will effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir which would not otherwise be drained, absent the approval of the exceptional location.

4) To consider any and all other matters which the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

Order 1106-A was promulgated by the Office of Conservation on July 11, 1989 establishing rules and regulations and creating drilling and producing units for the North Searcy Field of LaSalle Parish, Louisiana for the Wilcox A through C Zones, Reservoir A. The order provides that

additional wells located in the North Searcy Field, within or outside any of the units created thereby, should not be drilled within 330 feet of any unit boundary or within 660 feet of any other well which has been permitted for, drilled to or completed in the same zone. The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A was fully and completely defined by Order 1106-A.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Order 1106-A as that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 1893 feet and 2690 feet (electric log measurements) in the Hunt Petroleum Corporation - IPB LLS No. 69 Well, located in the NE/4 of SE/4 of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

The applicant attaches hereto a plat showing the location for which this special permit is sought.

Inasmuch as the matters covered by this application do not require a pre-application notice, no such notice has been given and it is requested that the hearing be held after the necessary ten day delay following legal advertisement.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the applicant has made a diligent effort to obtain the names and addresses of all interested owners and represented parties to whom notice of this application should be sent and a list of such names is attached hereto.




