Re: **APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING  
MUNOCO COMPANY  
WILCOX A ZONE, RESERVOIR A, SU170  
LITTLE CREEK FIELD  
LASALLE PARISH, LOUISIANA**

Application is hereby made on behalf of MUNOCO COMPANY (Applicant) to the Commissioner of Conservation for calling of public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters concerning Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, SU170 of Little Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana:

- 1) To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 856-E, so as to permit the Applicant to designate and utilize their Munoco Company – Placid Fee P No. 003 Well for production of oil and gas from the Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A within the unit designated WX A RA SU170, Little Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana; such well site position being shown on the attached survey plat and made a part hereof.
- 2) To grant status of the previously drilled and completed Munoco Company – Placid Fee P No. 003 Well as the Unit Well for WX A RA SU170 Tract.
- 3) To determine that the proposed drillsite position will enable more effective and efficient drainage of a portion of the reservoir which can not be drained by any other well located therein.
- 4) To designate Munoco Company as the Operator of such Unit Well.
- 5) To consider any and all other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate concerning this application and request.

Office of Conservation Order No. 856-E was promulgated effective 01 January 1986, and established rules, regulations and created drilling/production units for the Wilcox A thru H Zones of the Little Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana. This order provides that no well shall be drilled within 330 feet of an existing unit boundary or within 660 feet of any other well which has been permitted for, drilled to, or completed within the same zone.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the Little Creek Field of LaSalle Parish, Louisiana was defined as being that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 1730 feet and 2386 feet (electric log measurement) in the Louisiana-Hunt Petroleum Corporation – Taylor No. A-1 Well, located in Section 25 Township 9 North, Range 1 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.



The subject matter of this application does not require a pre-application notice nor pre-hearing conference. Accordingly, no notice has been issued, and it is requested that the hearing be held after the necessary ten (10) day delay following legal advertisement.

Pursuant to the revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties to whom this notice of application is being sent. A copy of this letter and the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Monroe District Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties as shown on the attached list.

We are enclosing our check in the amount of \$755.00, made payable to the Office of Conservation, to cover the applicable hearing fee.




