Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A and Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A in the Longwood Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

In its application, Goodrich Petroleum Company intends to request the following, to wit:

Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A

1. To create six (6) single drilling and production units of approximately 640 acres for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, designated as the HA RA SUA, HA RA SUB, HA RA SUC, HA RA SUD, HA RA SUE and HA RA SUG, Longwood Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. That any wells to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the units created herein, should be located no closer than three hundred-thirty (330') feet from the any unit boundary and no closer than six hundred-sixty (660') feet from any other well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to said reservoir,
3. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said units;
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
5. To designate a unit operator and unit wells for the units created herein;
6. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A

1. To create three (3) single drilling and production units of approximately 640 acres for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SURR, SUUU and SUVV, designated as the CV RA SURR, CV RA SUUU and CV RA SUVV, Longwood

Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, al, as shown more particularly on the attached plat;

2. That any wells to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, within or outside of the units created herein, should be located no closer than six hundred-sixty (660') feet from the any unit boundary and no closer than two thousand (2,000') feet from any other well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to said reservoir;
3. To redefine the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective September 20, 1978, as corrected and Amended of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective March 29, 1983, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar AS the CV RA SUJJ, CV RA SUKK, CV RA SUS are concerned as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 8,170 feet and 10,358 feet in the Winchester Production Co.-Chandler 19 No. 1 Well, located in Section 19, Township 18 North, Range 16 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana;
4. To confirm the units established by Office of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective September 20, 1978, as corrected and Amended of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective March 29, 1983;
5. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the units created herein;
6. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
7. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective September 20, 1978, as corrected and Amended of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective March 29, 1983 shall remain in full force and effect;
8. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

Commingling

1. To grant permission to applicant to combine downhole production from the:

CV RA SUS and HA RA SUG
CV RA SURR and HA RA SUB

in the wellbore of any existing and future wells located on said units. The interests of the working interest owners and royalty owners in the units are identical;
2. To continue in full force and effect the provisions of Series of Office of Conservation Order Nos. 123-A and Series of Office of Conservation Order Nos. 994-D.
3. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, Longwood Field, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 123-A-2, effective September 20, 1978, as corrected and Amended Correction to Order No. 123-A-2, effective March 29, 1983 and is hereby defined or redefined in the Longwood Field, as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 8,170 feet and 10,358 feet in the Winchester Production Co.-Chandler 19 No. 1 Well, located in Section 19, Township 18 North, Range 16 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, **ONLY AS TO THE CV RA SUJJ, CV RA SUKK, CV RA SUS, CV RA SUUU, CV RA SUVV and CV RA SURR.**

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, Longwood Field is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 10,910 feet and 11,487 feet in the Chesapeake Operating, Inc.-SRLT 29 No. 1 Well, located in Section 29, Township 16 North, Range 15 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

The Commissioner of Conservation has waived the twenty (20) day pre-application notice requirement provided for in Rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation and that rule is not applicable to this hearing application.
