Application is hereby made on behalf of **KAISER-FRANCIS OIL COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To dissolve the existing 1st DUHON RG SUA, previously created by Office of Conservation Order No. 155-D-5, effective December 1, 1973, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 1st Duhon-Wise Zone, Reservoir A, in Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, said revised unit designated 1st DUHON-WISE RA SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed revised unit in accordance with the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 155-D-5, effective December 1, 1973 (net acre-foot basis of participation).
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the proposed unit within or outside the unit created herein, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. Except to the extent herein set forth, to confirm and continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 155-D-5, effective December 1, 1973, and applicable statewide orders.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The First Duhon Sand, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 155-D-5, effective December 1, 1973.

The 1st Duhon-Wise Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,640 feet and 10,990 feet (electrical log measurements) (10,494 feet and 10,844 feet – true vertical depths) in The Superior Oil Company – L.S. Goldberg No. 3 (ST) Well, located in Section 68, Township 12 South, Range 3 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was held on May 5, 2008, at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance. The conference was opened by Mr. David Comeaux, representing the applicant, who explained the bases for the unit proposal. Questions were asked and answered. Mr. Comeaux mentioned that the applicant would possibly revise its plan to request that unit production be shared on a net acre-foot basis. No opposition was expressed, and the conference was then adjourned.

Since the conference, the applicant has determined that it would be more appropriate to request participation on a net acre-foot basis as mentioned to those present at the conference in keeping with the manner in which production from the original unit was previously shared. No other change in the original proposal or unit outline is being requested. Should any parties receiving a copy of this notice have questions or wish to consult, please contact the undersigned.


