Dear Commissioner Welsh,

Application is hereby made on behalf of SE USA Operating, Inc. for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the above captioned sand and reservoir, in the Leleux Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the MARG VAG Zone, Reservoir A, in the Leleux Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in production on a surface acre basis.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Marg Vag Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the proposed unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1909 et seq. (Statewide Order 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify Marg Vag Zone, Reservoir A by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner.
5. To consider any other matters which may be pertinent to this application.

The MARG VAG Zone in Reservoir A in the Leleux Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana is defined as that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered in the measured depth interval from 14,253' to 14,605' in the Damson Oil Corporation-Adams No. 1 Well (SN 184626) located in Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 1 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

All pertinent data, including well logs, may be obtained, AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY, from W. H. Robbins & Associates, LLC, 302 La Rue France, Suite 100, Lafayette, LA 70508; Phone (337) 232 5004.

A pre-application conference was not held as there was no request for a conference.

A plat outlining the proposed unit is attached hereto and made a part of this application. There is enclosed a list of names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties who are being forwarded this application and plat. Such list is being forwarded ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of Interested Owners and Represented Parties, and Interested Parties will be furnished by the undersigned to any party requesting a copy of it. This list includes the names and addresses of all Interested Parties who are known to the applicant, after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed herewith our check in the amount of \$755.00, made out payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.


