Dimension Energy Company, L.L.C. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 5900' Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Hatch Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish a single reservoirwide unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the 5900' Sand, Reservoir A, Lake Hatch Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, such unit being designated LH 5900' RA SU, in accordance with the provisions of LSA-R.S. 30:5C (Act 441 of 1960), as amended.

2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the proposed reservoirwide unit.

3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracks, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed reservoirwide unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.

4. To designate Applicant as Operator of the proposed reservoirwide unit for the 5900' Sand, Reservoir A.

5. To exempt the proposed reservoirwide unit from the well location provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.

6. The 5900' Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Hatch Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 6359' to 6484' (electrical log measurements) in The Dimension Energy, L.L.C.- LL & E B No. 71 well; (WSN 233519). Located in Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 6 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

At the public hearing on this matter Applicant will present evidence showing that the proposed unit operation of the reservoirwide unit is economically feasible, will appreciably increase the ultimate recovery of hydrocarbons from the 5900' Sand, Reservoir A, and will prevent the drilling

of unnecessary wells. Accordingly, creation of the reservoirwide unit is appropriate under the provisions of LSA-R.S. 30:5C (Act 441 of 1960), as amended.

Applicant has secured concurrence of the proposed reservoirwide unit by more than 75% in interest of the Owners and Royalty Owners as those terms are used in LSA-R.S. 30:5C (Act 441 of 1960), as amended.

Pertinent data concerning this application is available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Blvd., Ste. 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person wishing to inspect such data should call the undersigned at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.

As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Pursuant to the aforesaid Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of this letter, and of the attached plat, is being sent to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties, as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause the Legal Notice to be published in a newspaper published in the general area of Lake Hatch Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the required application fee is enclosed.


