

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2009**, upon the application of **BP AMERICA PRODUCTION COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Pettit Zone**, in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the Pettit Zone, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as the PET SUR, PET SUS, PET SUT and PET SU58, are concerned, as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 6,045' and 6,355' (electrical log measurements) in the BP America Production Company (formerly Vastar)-Christian No. 2 Well, located in Section 35, Township 12 North, Range 15 West.
2. To confirm and continue in effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 28-E, effective October 3, 1944, as amended and supplemented by the 28-E Series of Orders.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Pettit Zone was previously defined in Order No. 28-E, effective October 3, 1944, and the applicant proposes it be redefined in the manner set forth in Item No. 1 above only insofar as Sand Units R, S, T and 58 are concerned.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
