Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **J & R OIL COMPANY LLC** to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Planulina Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Planulina Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that any well drilled outside of the Planulina Zone, Reservoir A, shall be in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The Planulina Zone, in the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 8,960' and 9,950' (electrical log measurements) in the Rio Bravo - Granger No. 1 Well, located in Section 14, Township 12 South, Range 8 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.

Any pertinent data relating to the subject application can be obtained, **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY**, from David Comeaux at Leon E. Comeaux & Associates, P. O. Box 53922, Lafayette, Louisiana 70505, (337-233-9839).

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana, on August 27, 2009 at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance.

The conference was opened with a discussion by Mr. David Comeaux, representing J & R Oil Company LLC, concerning the nature and purpose of the conference and the bases for the applicant's proposed unit. Two landowners suggested a 320 acre unit proposal which partially encompassed a different geographical area than the applicant's plan. The parties were unable to reach a compromise. Opposition is expected at the hearing.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof a plat outlining the proposed unit, the conference attendance list, and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties and proposed unit plat (**being the same plat attached to the August 5, 2009 preapplication notice**) are being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, said plat and the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, J & R Oil Company LLC, in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.
