Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ALINET CORPORATION** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 10,000' Zone, Reservoir A, in the Duson Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 10,000' Zone, Reservoir A, in the Duson Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit to be designated 10000 RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate Alinet Corporation as operator of the proposed 10000 RA SUA;
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the above mentioned zone should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901, et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E);
5. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the 10,000' Zone, Reservoir A.


The 10,000' Zone, Reservoir A in the Duson Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 9,450 feet and 10,950 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Amarillo Oil Company – Simon Duhon No. 1 Well, located in Section 32, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was held on August 28, 2009 in Lafayette, Louisiana at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance. The conference was opened by representatives of the applicant, who explained the bases for the unit being requested. Questions were asked and answered. Mr. David Comeaux on behalf of Willie P. Arceneaux, Jr., etal presented a counterplan moving the southern boundary further south and removing acreage on the north. Mr. Larry Hebert, on behalf of M. Harson, presented a counterplan adding additional acreage on the south. During the conference, the applicant resolved differences with the all parties presenting counterplans. The compromise unit is depicted on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof. As a result of this compromise, no opposition is expected at the hearing to be scheduled in this matter.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the 10000 RA SUA, Duson Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom this application is being mailed. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be furnished to any party requesting a copy. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties. Also enclosed is a check payable to the Office of Conservation representing the required hearing application fee.
