On behalf of Tensas Delta Exploration Company, LLC, application is hereby made for a public hearing to receive evidence concerning the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Rodessa Zone, Reservoir B, Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, and the Pettit Zone, Reservoir B, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create seven (7) additional drilling and production units (to be designated as ROD RB SUY thru ROD RB SUEE) for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Rodessa Zone, Reservoir B, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, as shown on the plat attached hereto.
2. To establish rules and regulations and create five (5) drilling and production units (to be designated as HOSS RA SUA thru HOSS RA SUE) for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, as shown on the plat attached hereto.
3. To force pool and unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases, and other property interests within each of the proposed units, with allocation of production to the tracts within each of such units to be on the basis of surface acreage.
4. To designate Tensas Delta Exploration Company, LLC. as the unit operator and to designate its Slagle, et al No. 1 Well as the unit well, at the location shown on the attached plats, for the proposed ROD RB SUAA and HOSS RA SUC.
5. To authorize the downhole combination of production from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A and the Pettit Zone, Reservoir B, in the wellbore of any well drilled on the proposed HOSS RA SUC thru HOSS RA SUE and the proposed PET RB SUN thru PET RB SUR, (pending under Docket No. 09-849), in the Rodessa Field, as to which the acreage and ownership are identical.
6. To explicitly find that said downhole combination of production is in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste and will maximize the efficient and economic recovery of gas and condensate from such zones and reservoirs.
7. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 7-E-1, effective May 25, 1982, to the proposed Rodessa Zone, Reservoir B units.
8. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, within or outside of the units created herein, should be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit line and no closer than 900 feet between wells drilling to, completed in, or for which a permit shall have been granted to drill to the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A.
9. To consider such other matters and issue such orders as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Rodessa Zone, Reservoir B, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 7-E-1, effective May 25, 1982.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, shall be defined as that oil and gas bearing interval between the depths of 6,577 feet and 7,600 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Chaparral Energy, L.L.C. (formerly Marshall Exploration) - National Gasoline Co. of LA No. 1 Well, (Serial No. 178601), located in Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 15 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

The Pettit Zone, Reservoir B, in the Rodessa Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 7-J-1, effective May 25, 1982.

Pertinent data concerning the intended application will be made available for inspection at the offices of Blanchard, Walker, O'Quin & Roberts, Chase Tower, 400 Texas Street, Shreveport, Louisiana 71163-1126. Any person wishing to inspect such data should call Wm. Timothy Allen III at (318) 221-6858 during normal business hours or write Mr. Allen at the above address, in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data can be obtained AT THE EXPENSE OF THE REQUESTING PARTY.

A list of the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties (as defined in the Revised Rules of Procedure) is attached hereto, and a copy of this notice, with the annexed plats, is being sent to each of such persons. A reasonable effort has been made to determine that the enclosed list includes all of the persons to whom this notice must be sent under the Revised Rules of Procedure.

By Pre-Application Notice dated August 13, 2009, applicant advised the Commissioner of Conservation, the District Manager and all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties of applicant's intention to apply for the hearing which is the subject of this application. Applicant received no timely request for a Pre-Application Conference, and accordingly, no conference will be held.

A check in the amount of \$2,265.00 made payable to the Commissioner of Conservation is enclosed herewith as the statutory fee for holding the requested hearing.






