Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Stone Energy Corporation to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, insofar and only insofar as to the existing unit designated BF-4 RA SUC, which unit is shown on an attached plat, as occurring between 7,585' to 7,832' electric log measured depths (7,374' to 7,614' true vertical depths) in the Stone Energy Corporation - Goodrich Cocke No. 7 (ST) Well, located in Section 26, Township 14 South, Range 6 East, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

2. To confirm the unit designated BF-4 RA SUC as remaining in full force and effect for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A, as proposed to be redefined herein.

3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, is currently defined as to BF-4 RA SUC in Office of Conservation Order Nos. 146-WW-2, effective June 3, 2003 and 146-WW-3, effective August 1, 2006.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.

Any pertinent data relating to the subject application can be obtained, **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY**, from Cambe Geological Services, 6300 Westpark, Suite 400, Houston, Texas 77057 (713-659-8363).

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication notice was given, but no request for a conference was received, and therefore, none was held.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof a plat outlining the proposed unit and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties and proposed unit plat (being the same plat attached to the September 1, 2009 notice) are being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, said plat and the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Stone Energy Corporation, in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.


