Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Caspiana Field**, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 191-H Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create three (3) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units to be designated HA RA SU57, HA RA SU130, and HA RA SU131;
2. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as the proposed units referenced herein are concerned, in accordance with the DEFINITION section hereof;

3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of, and a unit well for each of the proposed units, if appropriate;
5. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the proposed units, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset wells(s) should be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
6. To extend to the proposed units, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 191-H Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

DEFINITION - The Haynesville Zone, in the Caspiana Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, and is hereby redefined **INSOFAR AND ONLY INSOFAR** as the proposed units referenced herein are concerned, in accordance with the definition provided in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H-22, effective November 6, 2008.

The pre-application conference tentatively scheduled for September 21 2009, **WILL NOT BE HELD**, as it was not requested within the delays provided for by the Rules of Procedure; therefore, no opposition to this Application at the hearing is anticipated.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof two (2) plats outlining the proposed units and a list of the names and addresses of the interested parties to whom this unitization proposal is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation. However,

the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

You may have received this Pre-Application Notice even though your property is not included in the proposed units, because the Revised Rules of Procedure require us to attempt to also notify everyone owning an interest in the area "proximate to" the proposed units.

Your receipt of this Pre-Application Notice does not require you to take any action. It is meant to notify you of these proceedings so that you have the opportunity to participate if you so desire.




