### **APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING**

Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Justiss Oil Company, Inc., P.O. Box 2990, Jena, LA 71342, for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1) To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Order 1237-A so as to permit the drilling of the "Justiss Oil Company, Inc. Placid Fee SUMV No. 10" well at a location 50 feet from the North line and 50 feet from the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 9 North, Range 2 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

2) To designate the Justiss Oil Company, Inc.- Placid Fee SUMV No. 10 well as a substitute unit well at said exceptional location for the Wilcox G Zone, Reservoir C, in Sand Unit D as defined and described by Order No. 1237-A-19.

3) To determine that the proposed location will effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir which would not otherwise be drained, absent the approval of the exceptional location.

4) To consider any and all other matters which the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

Order 1237-A was promulgated by the Office of Conservation on March 11, 1986, effective on or after January 1, 1986, establishing rules and regulations and creating drilling and producing units for the Summerville Field of LaSalle Parish, Louisiana. The order provides that additional wells located in the Summerville Field, within or outside of the units created thereby, should not be drilled within 330 feet of any unit boundary or within 660 feet of any other well which has been permitted for, drilled to or completed in the same zone.

Order 1237-A-19 was promulgated by the Office of Conservation on October 14, 2002,

effective on or after September 17, 2002. Order 1237-A-19 created Sand Unit D for the Wilcox G Zone, Reservoir C in the Summerville Field, and incorporated the provisions of Office of Conservation Order 1237-A by reference.

The Wilcox G Zone in the Summerville Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana was fully and completely defined by Order 1237-A as being that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 2829 feet and 2851 feet (electric log measurements) in the Placid Oil Co. - Tremont No. A-19 Well, located in Section 26, Township 9 North, Range 2 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

The designation of a substitute unit well as the exceptional location is necessary because the existing unit well, the Placid Fee SUMV # 6 has experienced severe casing problems and will be plugged and abandoned upon the drilling of the SUMV No. 10.

The proposed substitute unit well will recover reserves that will not be produced from the unit absent this exceptional location.

The applicant attaches hereto a plat showing the proposed location for which this special permit is sought.

Inasmuch as the matters covered by this application do not require a pre-application notice, no such notice has been given and it is requested that the hearing be held after the necessary ten day delay following legal advertisement.



The applicant will also cause a copy of the legal notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in LaSalle Parish, Louisiana and shall post a copy of the notice in a prominent place in the LaSalle Parish Courthouse.

A copy of this letter, the attached plat and list of interested owners and represented parties is being sent to Joseph F. DeVall, District Manager of the Monroe District Office.

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$755.00 in payment of the required filing fees.


