

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2009**, upon the application of **LIVE OAK ENERGY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Sand, Reservoir B**, in the East Haynesville Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize the Live Oak Energy, Inc.-Averett Trust No. 1 Well, as a substitute unit well for HA RB SUN at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize the Live Oak Energy, Inc.-Ray Burnham No. 1 Well, as an alternate unit well for HA RB SUN at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To explicitly find that the proposed substitute and alternate unit wells are reasonable and in the interest of conservation and are necessary to drain a portion of the Haynesville Sand, Reservoir B, underlying HA RB SUN, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well in such unit.
4. To provide that the unit allowable for such unit may be produced from either the unit well, the alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Sand, Reservoir B is fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 105-J-1, effective April 25, 1990.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
