

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2009**, upon the application of **DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION COMPANY LP**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Gray Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Devon Energy Production Company, LP to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well for GRAY RA SUH at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, or at a location within a fifty foot radius of the location shown provided that such location shall be no closer than 330 feet to any unit line when the directional equipment is removed from the wellbore.
2. To the extent necessary, to approve an exception to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 164-Q, effective July 12, 1979, for the proposed alternate unit well.
3. To establish that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically recover hydrocarbons underlying GRAY RA SUH which cannot be recovered by any existing well on the unit.
4. To authorize the unit allowable for GRAY RA SUH to be recovered from the existing unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, in the discretion of the operator.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Gray Sand, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 164-Q, effective July 12, 1979.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
