APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Devon Energy Production Company, L. P. hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Gray Sand, Reservoir A, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Devon Energy Production Company, L. P. to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well for GRAY RA SUH at the location shown on the attached plat, or at a location within a fifty foot radius of the location shown provided that such location shall be no closer than 330 feet to any unit line when the directional equipment is removed from the wellbore;
2. To the extent necessary, to approve an exception to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 164-Q, effective July 12, 1979, for the proposed alternate unit well;
3. To establish that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically recover hydrocarbons underlying GRAY RA SUH which cannot be recovered by any existing well on the unit;
4. To authorize the unit allowable for GRAY RA SUH to be recovered from the existing unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, in the discretion of the operator; and

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5. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Gray Sand, Reservoir A, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 164-Q, effective July 12, 1979.

The subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice.


