LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2009**, upon the application of **PENNINGTON OIL & GAS INTERESTS, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL and 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL**, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant permission to applicant to combine down hole production from the Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL and 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, in the well bore of any existing and future wells located on said units. The interests of the working interest owners and royalty owners in the units are identical.
2. To further define the Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, created by Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-A-7, effective March 19, 1997, the 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, created by Order No. 1046-F, effective July 23, 2002 and the 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, created by Order No. 1046-D, effective June 2, 1998.
3. To confirm Pennington Oil & Gas Interests, LLC as operator of the Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL, 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL and 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A SUL.
4. To continue in full force and effect the provisions of Order No. 1046-A-7, effective March 19, 1997, Order No. 1046-F, effective July 23, 2002 and Order No. 1046-D, effective June 2, 1998.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 1046, effective September 6, 1978, as amended and supplemented by the 1046-A Series of Orders and is hereby further defined in the L TUSC RA SUL as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 20,430' and 20,870' (electrical log measurements) in the Pennington Oil & Gas Interests, LLC-Bomer Blanks No. 1 Well, located in Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 9 East.

The 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 1046-F, effective July 23, 2002 and is hereby further defined in the 20,800 TUSC RA SUL as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 20,870' and 21,345' (electrical log measurements) in the Pennington Oil & Gas Interests, LLC-Bomer Blanks No. 1 Well, located in Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 9 East.

The 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 1046-D, effective June 2, 1998 and is hereby further defined in the 21,100' TUSC RA SUL as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 21,345' and 21,538' (electrical log measurements) in the Pennington Oil & Gas Interests, LLC-Bomer Blanks No. 1 Well, located in Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 9 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
