APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

WSF, Inc. hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize the downhole or wellbore combination of production from any combination of HOSS RA SU12, CV RA SU12 and/or LCV RA SU65 with respect to current or future wells located on said units, provided that ownership within each unit is the same;
2. To authorize the downhole or wellbore combination of production from any combination of HOSS RA SU13, CV RA SU13 and LCV RA SU59 with respect to current or future wells located on said units, provided that ownership within each unit is the same;
3. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-A-1, effective October 1, 1972, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-A-5, effective May 25, 1977, and subsequent orders of the 361-A Series of Orders.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-B, effective October 1, 1973, and was further defined by subsequent orders of the 361-B Series.

The Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Elm Grove Field, Caddo, Bossier, Webster, and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 361-E, effective July 16, 1996, and was redefined as to certain units by subsequent Orders of the 361-E Series of Orders.


The subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a Pre-Application Notice.
