APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

KCS Resources, Inc. hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Longwood Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish two additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Longwood Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, to be designated HA RA SUU and HA RA SUV, as shown outlined on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate unit wells and unit operators, as appropriate;
4. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Longwood Field, INsofar as HA RA SUU and HA RA SUV are concerned, as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 9,220 feet and 10,880 feet (electric log measurements) in the Nadel & Gussman - Jetta Operating - Franks 22 No. 1 Well located in Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 14 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana;
5. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the proposed units, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the

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distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;

6. To extend the field rules established by Office of Conservation Order No. 123-K, effective June 17, 2008, to the proposed additional units for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Longwood Field, except to the extent inconsistent herewith; and
7. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Longwood Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 123-K, effective June 17, 2008.







