Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, GREENWOOD-
WASKOM FIELD, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

Dear Sir:

SAMSON CONTOUR ENERGY E&P, L.L.C. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create eight (8) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units being designated HA RA SUU through HA RA SUBB and being shown on the attached plat.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate an operator of, and unit wells for, the proposed units as may be appropriate.
4. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, insofar and only insofar as to these proposed additional units, as being that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 9,828 feet and 11,145 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Encore Operating Louisiana LLC (formerly Greystone Oil & Gas LLP)--Querbes No. 2 Well, located in Section 29, Township 16 North, Range 16 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
5. To provide that with respect to any horizontal well drilled to the Haynesville Zone within any of the proposed units, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary or offset well will be determined based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus.
6. To extend, except as in conflict herewith the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 270-MM series of Orders, to the proposed additional units.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to these proposals.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007.

A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


By letter dated January 5, 2009, Applicant gave notice, in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure, of its intention to apply for a public hearing concerning these proposals and set January 29, 2009, as the tentative date for the pre-application conference. While a timely request for the conference was received, it was subsequently withdrawn; therefore, no pre-application conference will be held.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of the plat showing the units proposed to be created (which is identical to the plat attached to the pre-application notice) is enclosed herewith, and a copy of this letter and of the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plat, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Greenwood-Waskom Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, enclosed herewith is our check payable to the Office of Conservation covering the application fee.


