Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Logansport Field**, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 28-AA, effective July 29, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 28-AA Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create four (4) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units to be designated HA RA SUT, HA RA SUU, HA RA SUV, and HA RA SUW;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;

3. To designate the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. - Blackstone, et al 26H No. 1 well as the unit well for HA RA SUT;
4. To designate the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. - Harts Bluff, LLC 34H No. 1 well as the unit well for HA RA SUU;
5. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of HA RA SUT and HA RA SUU;
6. To designate a unit well for HA RA SUV and HA RA SUW, and Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of same, if appropriate;
7. To extend to the proposed units, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 28-AA effective July 29, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 28-AA Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders; and
8. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 28-AA, effective July 29, 2008.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 22, 2009, at The Onebane Law Firm, 1200 Camellia Blvd., Suite 300, Lafayette, Louisiana. A list of the parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. Randall C. Songy, attorney for the applicant, opened the conference with a brief discussion on unitization. David Comeaux, geological consultant for the applicant, explained the applicant's proposal and the geological, engineering and other bases therefor, and answered questions. No counterplan was presented at the conference and no opposition is expected at the hearing. The conference was then adjourned.




