Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **APACHE CORPORATION** for the calling of public hearings after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders relating to the above referenced matters:

11,400' Zone, Reservoir C

1. To dissolve the existing 11400 RC SUA, previously established by Office of Conservation Order No. 14-KKK-4, effective August 1, 2006, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised unit designated 11400 RC SUA, for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate in the Golden Meadow Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To confirm and continue in effect Apache Corporation as operator of the proposed revised 11400 RC SUA.
4. To confirm and continue in effect its State Lease 378 No. 143 Well as unit well of the proposed revised 11400 RC SUA.

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5. To designate its LL&E No. 233 Well as alternate unit well for the proposed revised unit at the location shown on the attached plat, in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

6. Except to the extent herein set forth, to confirm and continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 14-KKK-4, effective August 1, 2006, and applicable statewide orders.

To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 11,400' Zone, Reservoir C, in the Golden Meadow Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 14-KKK-4, effective August 1, 2006.

Dulac Sand, Reservoir A

1. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Dulac Sand, Reservoir A, in the Golden Meadow Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, said unit designated DULAC RA SUA.

2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.

4. To designate Apache Corporation as operator of the proposed unit.

5. To designate its LL&E No. 233 Well as unit well for the proposed unit.

6. To provide that any future substitute and/or alternate unit wells drilled to the Dulac Sand, Reservoir A, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Dulac Sand, Reservoir A, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing should the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Dulac Sand, Reservoir A, in the Golden Meadow Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 14,700 feet and 14,781 feet (electrical log measurements) (true vertical depths of 13,787 feet and 13,843 feet) in the Apache Corporation – LL&E No. 233 Well, having a surface location in Section 64 and a bottom hole location in Section 70, Township 19 South, Range 21 East, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.






