APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Petrohawk Operating Company hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create a single additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, to be designated HA RA SUN, as shown outlined on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within the proposed unit in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate a unit well and unit operator, as appropriate;
4. To extend the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008, and all applicable Statewide Orders to the proposed unit, except to the extent inconsistent herewith;
5. To confirm that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the proposed unit, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary or well in an offsetting unit will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
6. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

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The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008.

A Pre-Application Notice dated February 9, 2009, was circulated in connection with this matter. No request for a conference was received; accordingly, no conference will be held.

A copy of this application, with plat attached, is being sent to each such party. A check for the appropriate application fee is enclosed with the copy of this letter being sent to the Commissioner of Conservation.


