

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 28, 2009**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **106 Zone, Reservoir A, SUA, SUB and SUC**, in the Caillou Island Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the 106 Sand, Reservoir A, SUA, SUB and SUC, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 411-C, effective July 1, 1966, and simultaneously therewith, to create three (3) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 106 Zone, Reservoir A, SUA, SUB and SUC.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the units so created, as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that the 106 Zone, Reservoir A, SUA, SUB and SUC, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the 106 Zone Reservoir A, SUA, SUB and SUC, by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 106 Zone is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 17,308' and 17,740' (electrical log measurements) in the Hilcorp Energy Company (formerly Texaco)-SL 188 LL&E Unit 3 No. 10 Well, located in Township 23 South, Range 20 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
