

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 28, 2009**, upon the application of **DENBURY ONSHORE, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Holt-Bryant Zone**, in the Delhi Field, Richland, Franklin and Madison Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To approve the carbon dioxide enhanced recovery project proposed by Denbury Onshore, LLC as a qualified tertiary recovery project pursuant LA R.S. 47:633.4.
2. To determine the amount of production which would have been recovered from the reservoir by utilizing only primary and secondary recovery methods.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Holt-Bryant Zone was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 96-G-4, effective May 1, 1975.

Application is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Monroe**, Louisiana.
