Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **TEXANA RESOURCES CORPORATION** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create two (2) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the WK&L 9 Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bateman Lake Field, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana, said units to be designated WK&L 9 RA SUA and WK&L 9 RA SUB, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the WK&L 9 Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the units created herein, should be located no closer than 330 feet to any unit line and no closer than 660 feet to any well on a competitive unit completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to the WK&L 9 Zone, Reservoir A.
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the WK&L 9 Zone, Reservoir A, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The WK&L 9 Zone, Reservoir A, in Bateman Lake Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 8,163 feet and 8,628 feet (electric log measurements) in the Texaco Inc., - Wax Bayou Co. No. 53 Well (SN 171339), located in Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana, and is further

defined between the measured depths of 7,658 feet and 8,093 feet in the Texas Company – WK&L No. 12 Well (SN 48385) located in Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana.


Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was held on March 9, 2009, in Lafayette, Louisiana, at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance. The conference was opened by representatives of the applicant who explained the bases for the units being requested. These representatives explained that the area being unitized was somewhat enlarged from the original proposal, then divided into two equal-sized units, thereby giving the applicant and offset operator the ability to independently develop their respective leasehold acreage. Several questions were asked and answered. No opposition was expressed. The conference was then adjourned.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, the list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be furnished to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, enclosed is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation submitted on behalf of the applicant representing the hearing application fee.




NOTE: ALL BOUNDARIES ARE GEOGRAPHIC
