Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **JORDAN OIL COMPANY**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 9800' Zone, Reservoir A, in the East Moss Lake Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 9800' Zone, Reservoir A in the East Moss Lake Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana;
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the 9800' Zone, Reservoir A, designated as the 9800 RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate Jordan Oil Company as operator of the proposed 9800 RA SUA and their Jordan No. 1 as the unit well;
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the above mentioned zone, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E);
6. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the 9800' Zone, Reservoir A.


The 9800' Zone, Reservoir A, in the East Moss Lake Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 9,030 feet and 10,493 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Conoco, Inc. (Union Oil Company of California) – Scheperle No. 1 (A-1) Well, located in Section 3, Township 11 South, Range 9 West, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was held on January 9, 2009 in Lafayette, Louisiana at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance. The conference was opened by representatives of the applicant, who explained the bases for the unit being requested. Questions were asked and answered. Mr. David Sturlese on behalf of the Gray Estate presented a counterplan extending the western boundary of the applicant's proposal farther to the west. After further discussion, the conference was adjourned. Since the conclusion of the conference, the applicant has resolved differences with the party presenting the counterplan. The compromise unit is depicted on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof. As a result of this compromise, no opposition is expected at the hearing to be scheduled in this matter.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are a plat outlining the applicant's proposal, the conference attendance list, and the list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, the list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be furnished to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties. Also enclosed is a check payable to the Office of Conservation representing the required hearing application fee.
