APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Questar Exploration and Production Company hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B, in the Woodardville Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize the applicant to drill, designate and utilize four alternate unit wells on CV RB SU66 at the exceptional locations and in the general manner shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof, or within one hundred feet of paths and bottom hole location shown, provided that there are no perforations in any wellbore closer than 330 feet to any unit boundary;
2. To authorize the applicant to drill, designate and utilize four alternate unit wells on CV RB SU70 at the exceptional locations and in the general manner shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof, or within one hundred feet of paths and bottom hole locations shown, provided that there are no perforations in any wellbore closer than 330 feet to any unit boundary;
3. To confirm that with respect to the proposed alternate unit wells that production casing will be run and cemented across the pool in which the well is to be perforated for production;
4. To determine there is the need for alternate unit wells on CV RB SU66 and CV RB SU70 to efficiently and economically recover hydrocarbons underlying these units;
5. To grant such exceptions to the well spacing provisions of Order No. 990-B, effective September 13, 2005, with respect to the Cotton Valley, Formation Reservoir B, as may be necessary with respect to the proposed alternate unit wells;

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6. To authorize the unit allowables for these units to be recovered from the existing wells on the units, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator; and
7. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.


The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B, in the Woodardville Field, Bienville and Red River Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 990-B, effective September 13, 2005, and was redefined as to specific units in subsequent orders, including CV RB SU66 by Office of Conservation Order No. 990-B-61, effective January 16, 2008, and CV RB SU70 by Office of Conservation Order No. 990-B-57, effective January 8, 2008.

Pursuant to Office of Conservation regulations, the list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be provided to any person requesting a copy of it. Also enclosed with the copy of this letter being mailed to the Commissioner of Conservation is a check for the fee required for this application.




