

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2009**, upon the application of **UNION GAS OPERATING COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Frio Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Port Barre Field, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Frio Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Union Gas Operating Company as operator of the proposed F RB SUA.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the Frio Zone, Reservoir B, should be located no closer than 50' from the nearest unit line.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Orders without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Frio Zone, Reservoir B is hereby defined as per Office of Conservation Order No. 116-T as being that stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 8,787' and 10,016' depths (electric log measurements) in the J. C. Trahan Drilling Contractor, Inc.-Joel Lanclos No. 1 Well, located in Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 4 East.
