MUNOCO COMPANY (OPR CODE 4347)
CREATION OF ADDITIONAL UNIT AND
UNIT WELL EXCEPTIONAL LOCATION
PLACID FEE WB NO. 6 (SN 238951)
SEC 25 T8N R2E TROUT CREEK FIELD
LASALLE PARISH, LOUISIANA**

Application is hereby made on behalf of MUNOCO COMPANY (Applicant) to the Commissioner of Conservation for calling of public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters concerning Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir C, in the Trout Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana:

- 1) To create an additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas or gas and condensate from the Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir C, in the Trout Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana and said unit to be designated WX A RC SUVV as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2) To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral interests and other property interests within the proposed unit and with each sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 3) To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1267-A, so as to permit the Applicant to complete, designate and utilize their Munoco Co - Placid Fee WB No. 6 Well as the unit well for production of oil and gas or gas and condensate from the Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir C within the proposed unit designated WX A RC SUVV, Trout Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana; such well location being shown on the attached unit plat and made a part hereof.
- 4) To grant status of the previously drilled and completed Munoco Co - Placid Fee WB No. 6 Well as the unit well for WX A RC SUVV Tract.
- 5) To designate Munoco Company as the Operator of such Unit Well and WX A RC SUVV.
- 6) To determine that the requested completion wellbore will enable a more effective and efficient drainage of a portion of the reservoir within WX A RC SUVV which can not otherwise be drained by any other well located therein, absent approval of the exception to spacing provision.
- 7) To consider any and all other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate concerning this application and request.


Office of Conservation Order No. 1267-A was promulgated effective 01 January 1986, and established rules, regulations and created drilling/production units for the Wilcox A thru C Zones, Reservoirs A thru E, in the Trout Creek Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana. The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir C, in the Trout Creek Field of LaSalle Parish, Louisiana was defined as being that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 2536 feet and 3444 feet (electric log measurement) in the H.L. Hunt - Goodpine No. C-6 Well, located in Section 29 Township 8 North, Range 3 East, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana, LESS AND EXCEPT the B-1 Sand, Reservoir A, as defined in Order No. 1267, effective January 31, 1985, insofar and only insofar as said sand underlies the unit created by said Order. Order No. 1267-A provides that no well shall be drilled within 330 feet of an existing unit boundary, and not less than 660 feet from any other well completed in, drilling to or for which a permit has been granted to drill to such zone.

Pertinent data concerning this application is available for inspection at the offices of Earl W. Peavy, 1310 Pine Street Extension, Jena, Louisiana 71342. Any person wishing to inspect such data should call Earl W. Peavy at 318-992-4156 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of such pertinent data, that is otherwise not available from the Office of Conservation, can be obtained at the expense of the requesting party.

Pre-Application Notice was given to Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties pursuant to correspondence dated 21 April 2009. No Pre-Application Conference, timely scheduled or otherwise, was requested. Accordingly, originally noticed Pre-Application Conference scheduled for Tuesday 12 May 2009 is cancelled by Applicant consistent with rule.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application and plat is being sent. A list of such names and addresses is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Monroe District of the Office of Conservation. However, such list of parties will be furnished to any party specifically requesting copies.

We are enclosing our check in the amount of \$755.00, made payable to the Office of Conservation, to cover the applicable hearing fee.
